## **Research Analysis**

HB2368 allows 50 percent of the earned income tax credit to be refundable to eligible taxpayers beginning tax year 2017. For tax year 2016, the credit was not refundable. For tax year 2015 and prior years, 100 percent of the credit was refundable.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure allows taxpayers eligible to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) to receive refunds equaling fifty percent (50%) of the amount beyond that which exceeds taxes owed.

The Tax Commission estimates the provision will result in a net revenue decrease of \$14.1 million.
