Research Analysis

HB2376 provides legislative approval for tribes with an agreement pursuant to the Model Tribe Gaming Compact to conduct *non-house-banked table games* upon written election to operate such games. In exchange, the tribe must pay a fee to the state equal to 10 percent of the monthly net win of the common pools or pots from which prizes are paid for non-house-banked table games. The measure also authorizes the Governor to negotiate a supplement to existing compact agreements to allow *sport pools* when such games are authorized by federal law.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure modifies the statutes governing gaming by permitting certain non-house banked table games. Preliminary estimates of revenue resulting from the provisions approach \$20.0 million in the first year and approximately \$31.0 million in subsequent years.
