Research Analysis

HB2404 removes the State of Oklahoma, any political subdivision of the state and agencies of a political subdivision of the state from a list of entities exempt from sales tax. As a result, sales to contractors in connection with the performance of a contract with the state or any of its political subdivisions will also no longer be exempt. The measure also specifically names the institutions of the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the Oklahoma Municipal Power Authority and the Office of Management and Enterprise Services as entities that would no longer be exempt from sales tax.
