Research Analysis

The bill increases the teacher minimum salary schedule by \$1,000 in 2017-18, by \$2,000 in 2018-19, and by \$3,000 in school year 2019-20. It clarifies that the provisions of this section apply to all individuals recognized by the State Department of Career and Technology Education as teaching in full-time programs whether at a public school, technology center, or skills center site.

Fiscal Analysis

PCS for HB 2417 provides increases to the minimum salary schedule for teachers in public schools with an additional \$1,000 for the 2017-18 school year, an additional \$2,000 for the 2018-19 school year, and an additional \$3,000 beginning with the 2019-20 school year. Individuals recognized by the Department of Career and Technology Education as teaching in specified full-time programs are added.

Department of Education personnel provide the following fiscal cost estimates.
