Impact:	Increases the Workers' Compensation Commission's FY-18 apportionment to \$5 million; stipulates the Attorney General is responsible for funding its Workers' Compensation Fraud Investigation Unit

Hb2424 repeals a section of law that requires the commission to fund the Attorney General's workers' compensation fraud investigation unit. The measure also sets the FY 2018 appropriations for the WCC revolving fund at \$5 million.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2424:

- Clarifies language regarding the Workers' Compensation Commission Revolving Fund
- Removes language that requires the Commission to fund the Attorney General's Workers' Compensation Fraud Investigation Unit and makes the Attorney General responsible for the funding. The Attorney General currently has a revolving fund (220) for the purpose of financing this Unit.
- Increases the apportionment amount the Commission will receive in FY-18 from the tax on workers' compensation premiums from \$3 million to \$5 million.
