Research Analysis

The introduced measure stipulates that in any proceeding in which the nursing board is required to serve an order on an individual, the board may send the material to the address of record with the board. If the order is returned as undeliverable, and the records of the board indicate no change of address has been made, then the order and any subsequent material relating to the same matter will be deemed by the court as having been legally served. Additionally, if an individual applying for a multistate license has been continuously enrolled in the FBI's Rap Back Service since issuance of the initial multistate license then the individual will not be required to undergo another criminal history background check.
