The measure creates the Veteran's Memorial Bridge.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure directs the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to place permanent markers upon a bridge designating the "Veteran's Memorial Bridge". 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the armed forces or Oklahoma Highway Patrol who were killed in action. For this reason there should be no direct cost to ODOT for the signage required by this amendment.
