**Research Analysis**

HB 2523, as introduced, makes several changes to the Oklahoma Employment Security Act. The measure clarifies how base period wages are determined. The bill also clarifies how benefits apply in educational institutions, when services are performed in two successive academic years. Certain notices to employers would have to have an admonition that failure to respond to the notice may affect the employer's tax rate.

The measure requires that documents served on the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission regarding child support collection be forwarded to the appropriate state or local child support agency, and that service of process is not complete until the document is received by that office. Finally, the measure updates language relating to food stamps and food assistance programs.
