Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB 2527 allows the sheriff of any county to authorize certain employees of the county, who possess a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, to carry a concealed handgun when acting in the course and scope of employment within the courthouses of the county in which the person is employed. This authority to authorize an employee to carry in the courthouse does not allow the employee to carry the handgun into a courtroom, sheriff's office, adult or juvenile jail or any other prisoner detention area. The measure allows the board of county commissioners to authorize certain employees of the county, who possess a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, to carry a concealed handgun when acting in the course and scope of employment on county annex facilities or ground surrounding the county courthouse.
