**Research Analysis**

The measure requires the State Auditor and Inspector to perform an audit of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority every two years. The measure requires the audit to be completed within 90 days after the audit begins and conveyed to the Governor and Legislative leaders.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2530 requires periodic audits of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) by the State Auditor and Inspector (SAI). SAI has the statutory authority to bill agencies for the costs of audits; therefor, OTA would be responsible for the costs of such audits. Officials at SAI anticipate a cost ranging from \$50,000-100,000 per audit, in order to fulfill the obligations required under the provisions of the measure.
