**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute for HB 2550 authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to accept any and all gifts, donations, etc., and to hold funds or property received as gifts outright or in trust, or to invest them. Further, the Department is directed to use best efforts to comply with the terms of any conditional gifts. Finally, the measure prohibits any special consideration to be given by a state veterans' home due to any pledged or prior gift.
