**Research Analysis**

The introduced measure prohibits a teacher from entering into a contract with a charter school until they have been discharged or released from their original contract. A teacher who attempts to resign after the statutory deadline to go to work for another public or charter school without being released from their original contract will be in breach of their contract and may be subject to civil litigation.
