**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute removes language about the State Board of Education sponsoring a charter school only after a determination and recommendation has been made by the State Department of Education with regards to the Board's capacity to be a sponsor. The measure specifies that there must be clear support from members of the community within the geographical boundaries of the proposed charter school that is appealing for sponsorship from the state board. Lastly, the measure establishes appeal process procedures and requirements for sponsor proposals that have been rejected at the local district level.
