**Research Analysis**

HB 2622 provides that charges be filed within 30 days of a request by the bail bondsman in cases where bail bond services are used, bail is forfeited and the person fails to surrender themselves. Existing law makes this a felony. Further, the measure provides that failure to timely file the charges results in exoneration of the bond.
