**Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendments to HB 2632 provides that citizens, business owners and places of worship have the right to establish policies regarding the possession of weapons on property. The measure modifies the conditions under which physical or deadly force may be used against an intruder to include when the person who uses defensive force knew or had a reasonable belief that the person against whom the defensive force was used entered or was attempting to enter into a dwelling, residence, occupied vehicle, place of business or place of worship for the purpose of committing a forcible felony. The measure provides a definition for “place of worship” as any permanent building or space used for worship services, activities and business of the congregation.
