The Committee Substitute to HB 2643 removes a provision regarding driving under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance which requires the district attorney to seek enhanced punishment before the defendant can be required to participate in additional requirements.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2643 cleans up Oklahoma statutory language to match with federal requirements in order for ODOT to continue to receive federal funds. Due to this language, last fiscal year, ODOT did not receive ~\$14 million in federal funding which they would have if this statute met federal requirements.
