Research Analysis

The introduced measure establishes ambulance attendant and driver requirements. Ambulance attendants must be at least a licensed emergency medical technician to transport a patient. Likewise, drivers must be at least certified as emergency medical responders. The bill provides exceptions to these requirements for any EMS Region, ambulance service district or municipality that serves any part of or is located in or partly in a municipality with a population of less than five thousand according to the last Federal Decennial Census or any subsequent Federal Decennial Census. All drivers must successfully complete an emergency vehicle operator course approved by the State Department of Health within 120 days of employment and complete a refresher course approved by the department every two years.
