## **Research Analysis**

HB2722, as introduced, amends a definition within the Oklahoma Administrative Workers' Compensation Act. The measure modifies the term *employee* to exclude any person who is employed in ranching by an employer who has a gross annual payroll in the preceding calendar years of less than \$100,000 or any person employed in ranching that does not operate motorized machines. The exemption of individuals employed in agricultural, ranching or horticulture jobs applies to any period of time for which the employment existed, even if the person is employed in other activities for which the exemption does not apply. In these cases, the employer is only required to obtain workers' compensation coverage for the period of time that the employee engages in nonexempt activities.
