Research Analysis

The committee amendment removes the words “in dormitories, halls or any other type of student housing.” Additionally it replaces the word “hall” with the word “floor,” and it replaces the words “floor or in the same room” with “hallway.”

The measure requires the board of regents of each institution within the higher education system to adopt a policy that prohibits co-ed housing owned, leased, or on the property of the institution. This excludes housing for married couples or families. A policy may allow for co-ed housing in the same building or hall but not on the same floor or in the same room and access between these areas is controlled.
