**Research Analysis**

The introduced measure requires the board of regents of each institution within the higher education system to adopt a policy that prohibits co-ed housing in dormitories, halls or any other type of student housing owned, leased, or on the property of the institution. This excludes housing for married couples or families. A policy may allow for co-ed housing in the same building or hall but not on the same floor or in the same room and access between these areas is controlled.
