**Research Analysis**

The introduced measure requires district level teacher professional development programs to include consent and healthy relationships education. It stipulates the local Safe School Committee may develop a consent and healthy relationships education program. The program must be medically accurate and appropriate; promote safe and healthy relationships and teach students to recognize and prevent coercion, violence or abuse, including both physical and emotional abuse; and include education regarding relationship communication skills, emotional health, accountability and well-being in relationships and consent. The measure directs the State Department of Education to develop a model policy and deliver training materials to all districts regarding a rape or sexual assault response program and for a consent and healthy relationships program. School districts may use a commercial consent and healthy relationships program listed by the State Department of Health.
