Research Analysis

HB 2736 provides a mechanism for the registration of noncommercial trailers. Noncommercial trailers are to include implements of husbandry. The measure would require the Tax Commission to issue a distinctive number and certificate of registration and a decal to the owner of a noncommercial trailer. The decal is to be attached to the rear of the trailer in clear view. The fee for registration is set at \$15 to be collected every 3 years. The measure apportions the fee with \$9 to the General Revenue Fund, \$2 to the motor license agent, \$2 to the Firearms Instructors Revolving Fund, and \$2 to the Oklahoma State University-Agricultural Extension Division-Educational and General Operations Revolving Fund.

The measure repeals Title 47, Section 1133.3 relating to optional registration of noncommercial trailers.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2736 provides for a \$15 registration fee on noncommercial trailers every 3 years and provides for apportionment of such fees to the General Revenue Fund (\$9.00), motor license agents (\$2.00), the Firearms Instructors Revolving Fund (\$2.00), and the Oklahoma State University-Agricultural Extension Division- Educational and General Operations Revolving Fund (\$2.00).

The noncommercial trailers registration fees provided in HB 2736 will generate an estimated total over each 3 year period of \$2,625,000, or on average \$875,000 annually. Such an amount would result, on average, in annual apportionments as follows:
