Research Analysis

The Committee Substitute to HB 2754 provides for the annual registration of utility vehicles. All revenues derived from the annual registration of utility vehicles is to be apportioned to the Developmental Disability Waiver Program Revolving Fund. The fund is to be used to implement the developmental disability waiver program. The measure authorizes counties to restrict the operation of utility vehicles on county roads and county highways by resolution or ordinance.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure modifies the registration of utility vehicles by requiring annual registrations. Current law provides for the option to register such vehicles upon purchase. The Tax Commission is examining the potential for registration revenue. Any revenue collections from the annual registration will be apportioned to the newly created Developmental Disability Waiver Program Revolving Fund within the Department of Human Services.
