**Research Analysis**

The introduced measure requires school districts to use a validated risk assessment screener and consider rehabilitation progress records provided by a student, parent or guardian, treatment professional, organizations, government agencies and other professional involved in the care of a student, when determining if a child is ready to return to a regular school setting.
