**Fiscal Analysis**

The Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarship program is funded as an element of the State Department of Education's total appropriation for State Aid. The State Department of Education may retain up to 2.5% of the scholarship amount to pay for administrative services. As such, there is no need for additional appropriated dollars for administration of the measures expansion of the Scholarship program. HB 2782 in its current form is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
