Research Analysis

The Committee Substitute to HB 2796 requires manufacturers and distributors who are required to register with the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control make available all data required pursuant to federal law, federal rules and regulations and Section 827 of Title 21 of the United States Code. Beginning November 1, 2019, every manufacturer and distributor required to register is to provide all data required pursuant to federal law, federal rules and regulations and Section 827 of Title 21 of the United States Code on a monthly basis to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control in accordance with rules promulgated by the Director. The information maintained is to be confidential and access is limited to agents with OBND or the Attorney General, DEA Diversion Group Supervisor and multi county grand juries properly convened.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2786 upon review by OBND is determined to have some cost associated with implementation. According to the agency, “additional resources would be necessary to include manpower and a database system to track the information.” The revenue from a sister bill (HB 2795) is intended to fund this measure, although OBND estimates the cost might exceed the \$90,000 anticipated revenue from HB 2795.
