**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to HB 2818 modifies the name of the license that authorizes the purchase and import of beer into the state creating the brewer's or small brewer's license. The measure provides that all retail licensees, including caterer, special event and public event licensees, may only purchase beer from the beer distributor assigned to the territory within which the beer will be sold by the retail licensee at retail. The measure allows a licensed wine and spirits wholesaler having common ownership with the licensed beer distributor and operated by the commonly owned wine and spirits wholesaler or an employee of the commonly owned wine and spirits wholesaler to transport beer. The measure clarifies conditions under which a beer distributor or small brewer or brewpub license holder may accept damaged product.
