The measure creates the Department of Transportation and Aeronautics Commission Reform Act. The measure would consolidate the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and the Department of Transportation.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2877 in its current form would consolidate the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission (Aeronautics), a nonappropriated agency, into the Department of Transportation (ODOT), an appropriated agency. No material impact on the state budget or revenues is anticipated as a result of this consolidation, due to the fact that Aeronautics currently receives no appropriated dollars. Aeronautics is a self-funding agency, any savings related to eliminated redundancies in administration would remain in the revolving fund structure of ODOT and be utilized to fulfill the mission for which the revolving funds are dedicated. ODOT is not expected to experience material savings as a result of this consolidation. HB 2877 in its current form is not anticipated to have a material impact on state appropriations.
