## **Research Analysis**

HB2911, as introduced, creates the Work-based Learning Program under the authority of the Governor's Council on Workforce and Economic Development. The measure directs the council to initiate and coordinate the program by creating partnership with the State Department of Education, the State Regents for Higher Education, the State Department of Career and Technology Education and businesses throughout the state. The goal of the program is to generate at least 20,000 registered apprenticeship and internship positions by the end of 2020. Registration of a work-based learning program with the Secretary of State's office will cost \$25 initially and \$10 for an amended registration.
