**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 2924 expands the Oklahoma Funeral Board by two positions, from seven to nine members. Three of the members must have been actively engaged in the industry for no less than 5 years and be licensed under the Funeral Services Licensing Act, selected from a list the Governor may request from the Oklahoma Funeral Directors Association. Three members must be actively engaged in cemetery operation for no less than 5 years. Finally, three members would be chosen from the general public.

The measure also directs the Oklahoma Funeral Board to establish methods by which a consumer may file a complaint against a cemetery.
