**Research Analysis**

HB 2924, as introduced, expands the Oklahoma Funeral Board by two positions, from seven to nine members, with the two new positions to be appointed by the Speaker of the House and the Senate President Pro Tempore, respectively. The other seven positions remain gubernatorial appointments.

The measure also directs the Oklahoma Funeral Board to regulate cemeteries in the state in any manner chosen by the board and to promulgate rules for governing of cemeteries.
