Research Analysis

HB 2950, as introduced, provides for an Internet-based reporting method for scrap metal dealers not subject to a local designation for reporting. The measure further prohibits any person to sell or purchase copper wire in four-gauge size or larger, with certain exemptions. Finally, the bill prohibits a scrap metal dealer from providing payment for a vehicle until the certificate of ownership has been submitted to the Tax Commission or a tag agency, and the vehicle is determined not to be stolen.
