Research Analysis

HB 2951 would allow for the carrying of pistols, handguns, rifles without need of a license by a person who is a legal resident, 21 years of age or older, not a convicted felon, not otherwise disqualified from the possession or legal purchase of a firearm under state or federal law and not involved in a crime. No person would be authorized to carry into places prohibited by law. The measure further restricts those who may carry by prohibiting person dishonorably discharged from the military or those persons who have been indicted or charged with or convicted of various crimes. The measure prohibits persons not lawfully in the United States from possessing a firearm. Persons are required to identify that they are carrying a weapon to law enforcement during the course of any arrest, detainment or traffic stop. The measure allows peace officers to carry personal rifle or shotgun.
