## **Research Analysis**

The measure directs the Statewide Circuit Engineering Districts Board to develop a statewide procedure to protect county infrastructure during energy industry and utility company activity by requiring the following procedure:

- A bonding process, by which bonds are required equal to the cost of the reconstruction of the adjacent infrastructure as safeguarded against damage; or
- Memorandums of understanding or infrastructure maintenance agreements which are planned or negotiated in advance of industry activities.
