**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 3011 increases, from one to two, the number of apprentices able to receive training in a cosmetology or barbering establishment at any one time. The measure also reduces, from three thousand to two thousand, the hours of apprentice training that entitle the apprentice to take the licensing examination.
