Fiscal Analysis

HB 3018 has the potential to reduce Oklahoma's overall number of felony convictions. Eliminating the provision could create a cost savings; however, the potential savings would be contingent upon how many individuals are typically convicted for this crime. The average cost of incarcerating a person in DOC custody is \$52.90/day or \$19,300/year.
