**Research Analysis**

HB 3027 eliminates a provision relating to direct wine consumer's permit. Rather than issue a permit for those purchasing wine through direct shipping, the measure requires the holder of a direct wine shipper license to verify the age of the consumer.

The measure repeals Title 37A O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 3-106 which relates to Direct Wine Consumer's Permits.
