Research Analysis

HB 3042, as introduced, is the Oklahoma Veterans Facility Investment Act of 2018. The measure directs the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to develop and construct a long-term care facility for the purpose of assuming the operations of the Talihina veterans' center. The department may construct new facilities or may refurbish facilities on property currently owned by the state or property purchased or donated from other sources. The location of the new facility is to be determined by the Oklahoma Veterans Commission.
