**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3074 clarifies the definition of “canoe” and adds definitions of “kayak”, “kiteboard”, “paddleboard”, “sailboard”, and “water-thrust device” in the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor Registration Act. The measure exempts canoes, kayaks and paddleboats from registration requirements when powered only by human power. The measure allows such vehicles to be titled and registered at the request of the owner.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides definitions for canoes, kayaks, kiteboards and paddleboats within the Vessel and Motor Registration Act. The watercraft are included as those exempt from registration, provides that such vessels may be titled and registered at the request of the owner. The number of vessels that might be titled and registered cannot be reliably estimated.
