**Research Analysis**

HB 3086, as introduced, provides that employees hired at the Southwest Oklahoma Juvenile Center after January 1, 2019, be considered unclassified and in term-limited appointments. Those employees may be transitioned into non-term-limited employment after the initial term expires. The measure also modifies which employees of the Office of Juvenile Affairs are exempted from classified service.
