**Research Analysis**

The amendment to HB 3104 adds a definition of “plan of safe care” that is developed by DHS when it receives a referral that an infant has been diagnosed with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome or a Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder but the referral is not accepted for investigation. The plan must address, at a minimum, the health and substance use treatment needs of the infant and the affected family member or caregiver.
