Research Analysis

The introduced measure stipulates that the State Department of Education will notify school board members who have failed to complete their continuing education requirements for service on a board. Board members who are removed for failure to complete these requirements are prohibited from running for or holding a board of education seat for a two-year period. The measure establishes an appeal procedure for board members that have been notified they are not in compliance with their continuing education requirements.

Fiscal Analysis

If the Board elects to hire a hearing officer, the Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) estimates each hearing will require approximately two hours and the estimated hourly rate of a hearing officer is \$150. In 2017, the OSDE sent out notification letters to 23 school board members who did not meet the continuing education requirements.
