The measure would prohibit the salary of any state employee from being greater than 90% of the salary paid to the top chief executive of the agency, commission, board, department or program of the executive branch of which the employee is employed.

## Fiscal Analysis

HB 3138 limits state employee pay to 90% of the pay of the chief executive officer of the state employee's employer. The below chart identifies agencies with employees employed at salary levels in excess of the cap provided in HB 3138. If one assumes that each agency could reduce salary levels to comply with the provisions of HB 3138, while maintaining agency performance, the agencies could achieve costs savings equivalent to the amount identified in the column title "Total Identified Salary":
