Fiscal Analysis

HB 3139 limits agency chief executive officer pay to that of the Governor's. Currently there are 14 cases, totaling \$450,025, where chief executive officer pay eclipses the limit provided in the measure. If one assumes each agency could reduce chief executive pay to comply with the provisions of HB 3139, while maintaining agency performance, total cost savings equivalent to \$450,025 could be realized.
