Research Analysis

The measure would set the salary of the governor to an amount three times that of the state legislature. Likewise, the salaries of the following elected officials would be set to an amount equal to the governor:

- attorney general;
- state superintendent;
- members of the corporation commission;
- state treasurer;
- state auditor and inspector;
- state insurance commissioner; and
- commissioner of labor.

Similarly, the measure would set the salary of the lieutenant governor to an amount equal to 80% of the salary of the governor.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3140, restructures the pay schedule for statewide elected officials, connecting such pay to the pay scale for members of the Legislature. Beginning with the 57th Legislature, member pay will be \$35,021. The pay schedule for statewide elected officials will change as follows:
