**Research Analysis**

HB3155, as introduced, relates to a tax credit for electricity generated by a zero-emission facility. The measure provides that credits generated during any period of time may be carried forward as a credit against subsequent income tax liability for up to 10 years. Currently, this option is limited to credits generated prior to January 1, 2014. The measure also strikes language that allows credits generated on or after January 1, 2014 to be refundable at 85 percent of the value.
