**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB3225 directs the Oklahoma Tax Commission to make tax credit data available on its website. The information must be available free of charge, downloadable and offer users the ability to systematically sort and search the data. The measure also sets minimum standards for what type of information must be disclosed about each tax credit.
