Research Analysis

HB 3228, as introduced, prohibits a health care insurer from imposing a monetary advantage or penalty that would affect the choice of the insured, when a health care provider not participating in a preferred provider organization (PPO) accepts the highest reimbursement rate available for covered services. The measure further provides that, if a provider not participating in the PPO agrees to accept the highest reimbursement available under the agreement, the provider accepts the reimbursement as payment in full without balance billing the insured.

Finally, the bill prohibits an insurer issuing health benefit plans from terminating or refusing to issue or renew a contract with a physician participating in a PPO if the reason for the denial or termination is that the physician provided the insured a referral to another physician not participating in the network.
