**Research Analysis**

The first floor amendment changes the effective date from November 1, 2018 to November 1, 2019.

The measure stipulates that every person who requires a prescription for behavioral medication may have a pharmacogenomics profile conducted and recorded in the person's medical record. A person receiving the test is entitled to receive a copy of the results or to view them in the medical record.
