Research Analysis

The introduced measure requires a pharmacogenomics profile be conducted and recorded on persons who reside for more than 30 days in a nursing facility, specialized facility or in an assisted living center, and who require a prescription for behavioral medication. Residents are entitled to receive a copy of their results or to view them in their medical record. Lastly, every nursing facility, specialized facility and assisted living center must provide appropriate behavioral health services and be in accordance with a comprehensive assessment and the resident's pharmacogenomics profile.
